Assignment: Create a complex portfolio or personal website using Macromedia Dreamweaver

DIRECTIONS:

The grade for this assignment will be weighted twice as much as the other projects and test.

Plan and create an interactive web site authoring with Macromedia Dreamweaver according to the instructions from the instructor. The subject matter will be a web site showcasing your portfolio. Include your own original graphics, Quick Time® movies, Flash Animation etc. If you are not a graphic design major, create a personal web site.

Before you begin, you will have already designed graphical user interfaces by drawing on paper and then creating in Adobe Photoshop, as well as an interactivity flow chart drawn in Adobe Illustrator to show how each page will interconnect with links.

Absolutely everything must be inside the "root folder" you will name "portfolio". Be careful with your naming conventions. Every image has to be in the web site to be included and connected. Every file must be saved in the proper format and named properly with the correct file extensions (.jpg, .gif, .html, .mov, etc.) Never use capitals and or spaces. You must not name files using characters: " & ; , " ' % # @ * = \$ + Dreamweaver files end in ".html". It is imperative that the Dreamweaver file that opens and starts your site will be named only "index.html" and nothing else. Very important: All your files may be in sub-folders but everything, each file and folder, must be in an overall master folder for the website, known as the "root folder," that you will name "portfolio". All connectivity and any site changes must be made from within Dreamweaver.

Save your files in lower case and no spaces into the "root folder" and save to the instructor's drop box. Fill out this sheet, including hours invested, and attach to the front of the envelope. Turn in to the instructor on or before the due date.
